## Have you heard about Total Mobility?

Total Mobility is a nationwide scheme to help people with disabilities stay connected with their community.

If you have a disability that prevents you from using public transport, you could be eligible for a 50% discount on taxi fares to help you get around urban Whāngārei.

You must be over 14 years of age to qualify and eligibility also depends on whether you receive any other financial assistance for transport.
