Services Provided

Our main functions include providing support, information and education services. We have specialized support groups and can assist with interpreter bookings. We have a Service Coordinator and Needs Assessment service for the Deaf and we also provide equipment assessments and vocational services.

Interpreting Service

Needs Assessment and Service Co-ordination

We provide a three step Needs Assessment/Service Coordination service. This includes initial interview, service plan, and service coordination to meet your goals.

Equipment

We have a Service Coordinator who is an Accredited Equipment assessor to check if you qualify for equipment from government funding to meet your needs and assist with the installation of funded equipment.

Community Education

We organize a range of educational workshops presented in New Zealand Sign Language. Our workshops are open to all Deaf people. Keep an eye on our newsletter for upcoming workshops and programmes.
