Services Provided

Home visits to provide education and support for people living with epilepsy and their whanau/family and friends.

Aim: To increase the Management and understanding of Epilepsy.

Life style Management, types of seizures, Medications and services available.

To provide strategies to assist the person with epilepsy gain seizure control and build confidence.

Provide In-service Epilepsy Training for professionals who work with people with epilepsy such as caregivers, community agencies, nurses and teachers.

Educate Staff about Epilepsy in work places and schools to support the person with epilepsy
Recognise seizures and know what to do should a student or colleague have a seizure.

Facilitate meetings between clients when appropriate so they can support each other and share management strategies.

Promote Community awareness through speaking engagements in service clubs, workplaces, schools and recreational clubs.
