Services Provided

Our service is offered through a qualified and trained Fieldworker based in Auckland.

Most support is provided by phone /email.

Visits can be arranged if you are visiting Auckland.

The fieldworker will do home-visits in Northland twice a year, and is available to meet up with families and health professionals at this time, if requested.

Our Fieldworker for the Northland area can assist you by:

- Providing information about MND when you have been newly-diagnosed, and as your condition progresses.
- Helping you to understand the information and to apply it to your individual situation.
- Helping you to understand the health system, identify and access services you may need now and in the future.
- Providing information and support to health professionals involved in your care.
- Promoting communication and co-operation between the individuals and agencies involved in your care.
- If you want, we can help connect you with others who are living with MND.
