Definitions

Residential Facility: *Permanent living in a facility with staff on site providing 24/7 care and support*

Respite Care: *Provides families/whānau or carers with a planned, temporary break from caring for a person with disability through alternative support.*

Supported Living: *Supported Living is a service that helps disabled people to live independently by providing support in those areas of their life where help is needed, usually in their own home.*

Private Boarding: *Board is where a person lives in a house owned by someone else (not the persons parents) and pay them an agreed amount that can include expenses, eg, food, power or internet.*

Independent Living: *Able to live independently without support.*
